

- Clinically trained, Christian staff with a low patient-to-therapist ratio
- Comprehensive family counseling, not just individual care



A YEAR OF HEALING AND HOPE

As I reflect on the past sixteen months, I've seen firsthand how God's faithfulness fuels every step of our mission — and your generosity continues to be His instrument of hope and healing.

Walking with families who are desperate for Christ-centered, high-quality treatment has opened my eyes in ways I never expected. What I've seen isn't just data or trends — it's the face of the battle, the heartache, and the hope. And it's also where your giving is making the greatest difference.



WHAT WE'RE SEEING ON FRONTLINES

Trauma is the root cause.

When Ashes to Glory began, we mostly saw stories of substance abuse. But we've learned that addiction — in all its forms — is often just the symptom. The deeper issue is trauma. Until those wounds are healed, true recovery can't begin.

Familiar stories repeat.

Three themes rise again and again in our applications: adoption wounds, technology addiction, and significant childhood trauma. These experiences run deep and shape identity, attachment, and trust. Healing them takes time, skilled care, and the redemptive power of Jesus.

Quality, Christ-centered care is rare.

Many treatment programs advertise "trauma-informed" or "family support," but true transformation demands more than good intentions. It requires individualized, clinically excellent counseling — not one-size-fits-all group sessions or a monthly family phone call — rooted in biblical truth and grace. That combination is rare. I'm so grateful for the trusted centers we partner with that embody both clinical depth and the heart of Jesus.

The Church must be equipped.

It breaks my heart how often families tell us they don't feel safe bringing their struggles to church. Addiction and trauma aren't problems to avoid — they're invitations for the body of Christ to move closer. These aren't "out there" issues; they're right here in our neighborhoods, our homes, and yes, our pews.

We believe the Church — both the big "C" Church and local congregations — has a vital role to play. Our prayer is to help churches become *safe, informed, grace-filled spaces* where families can voice their struggles and find support, not shame.

The financial gap keeps growing.

Insurance rarely covers treatment for sexual related issues, and even standard residential care is often limited to 30 days. Add to that the rising costs of everything — including quality care — and the burden becomes impossible for most families to carry alone. This year, our average scholarship amount increased 11% compared to 2024. That's where your giving steps in — helping families cross a financial canyon they could never bridge alone.

God is bigger than all of it.

Even in the hardest stories, we see God's hand at work. Jesus came to heal the brokenhearted and make all things new — and that's what we witness every week: families reunited, faith renewed, and lives restored.

FROM MY HEART

As I reflect on all of this, I'm in awe of how God continues to move — not only through Ashes to Glory Foundation, but through you, our faithful donors and prayer partners. Every redemption story begins when someone chooses to give, to pray, and to care.

Thank you for believing that every life is worth fighting for and for being a living example of grace in action. **Your generosity is writing redemption stories that only Eternity will fully reveal, and together, we get to participate in what Jesus came to do — to heal, restore, and redeem.**

KEY EVENTS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS FROM 2025

- We launched our **new website** at the end of 2024, giving families, donors, and partners an updated, user-friendly way to learn more about our mission and get connected.
- We **strengthened our operations and systems** — new CRMs, improved financial tools, and enhanced cybersecurity to steward gifts with excellence.
- We earned **ECFA accreditation**, reaffirming our commitment to financial integrity and transparency.

- Also in June, we welcomed **Amber Prevo** as our **Family Scholarship Intake Coordinator**. Amber serves as the main contact for families during the application process and has already become a trusted, compassionate voice of hope for those walking through crisis.
- Throughout the year, Brandon shared our story and mission with churches and organizations across **Arizona, Michigan, Indiana, Arkansas, and Illinois** — raising awareness about trauma, addiction, and the redemptive work God is doing through Ashes to Glory.


